

# Virtual 2021 Virgin Money London Marathon Terms & Conditions

By applying for entry into the virtual 2021 Virgin Money London Marathon, I agree with Hospice Isle of Man that:

## Registration and Participation

1. Registration must be only be completed by those who will be aged 18 years or over on the date of the Event (Sunday 3rd October 2021).
2. I understand that Hospice Isle of Man have the right to refuse registration or application for a place in an Event without providing reasons for doing so and at any time.
3. Contact details provided are used to keep you up to date about the event you are taking part in. We may ask for next of kin details in case of an emergency. All details will be stored securely and are used in relation to the event you are taking part in.
4. You acknowledge that Hospice Isle of Man incurs costs as a result of you joining our marathon team e.g. if you have taken a virtual charity place then the cost of this place and also the cost of producing and sending fundraising packs/running vest/fundraising materials. The objective of joining our team is to raise as much money as possible to help us achieve our charity mission that will support our patients to live well, their way, to the end of their life.
5. In the event of injury, or if you can no longer take part in the event you must inform us by emailing [fundraising@hospice.org.im](mailto:fundraising@hospice.org.im) or calling 01624 647432. We regret that we are unable to refund any registration payments made to us nor can we guarantee a deferral to a future event.

## Charity Runners

1. We define a charity place runner in this case as anyone who has obtained a place in the virtual 2021 Virgin Money London Marathon directly from Hospice Isle of Man.
2. By obtaining your place, you have committed to **raise a minimum of £500** as a condition of the place.
3. Hospice Isle of Man has a very limited number of spaces in the virtual 2021 Virgin Money London Marathon and no guarantee can be given that your application will be successful.
4. If your application is successful, we will ensure that your place is reserved for the virtual 2021 Virgin Money London Marathon. You will be required to complete your registration on the race organisers online entry system by the deadline date, which will be set by the London Marathon Events company. We will provide you with full details of how to do this. If you do not complete the Virgin Money London Marathon online entry system you will lose your place and you will not be entitled to a refund or a deferral.
5. Upon acknowledgement of your successful application you will be sent a welcome email with more information. Our team is here to help. We will provide advice and support to help you with your fundraising and to achieve your minimum target.
6. The full 26.2 miles you have chosen to undertake must be completed on Sunday 3rd October 2021. Participants will have 23 hours, 59 minutes and 59 seconds (from 00:00 to 23:59:59 BST) to complete the 26.2 miles, which you can choose to run, walk or jog.
7. The virtual 2021 Virgin Money London Marathon does not take place on closed roads.

8. The 2021 Virgin Money London Marathon app, powered by TCS, requires the participant to enable GPS to track their 26.2 miles. Tracking information will be used to produce the individual certificate unique to the participant.
9. Runners are responsible for their own nutrition and hydration during the event.
10. All participants will be asked to upload proof of their time and official results will be published. Once this has been done, you will receive an iconic Virgin London Marathon finishers medal and t-shirt.

## Event Cancellation

1. By agreeing to these terms and conditions you understand that the event may be cancelled due to the ongoing global pandemic.
2. In the event that this happens, where possible, we will offer you a place in the same event on a future date. Please note, this is dependent on the terms from the event organisers.
3. If we are unable to offer you a place in a future event, we will offer you a place in an alternative event.

## Fundraising

1. You agree to comply with any fundraising guidance or advices issued by Hospice Isle of Man and abide by the Code of Fundraising Practice issued by the Fundraising Regulator.
2. You agree to collect money only on behalf of Hospice Isle of Man in connection with the Event. You must communicate this clearly with your supporters.
3. You agree to use only lawful means to fundraise for Hospice Isle of Man and will not do anything that harms or is likely to harm the reputation of Hospice.
4. All monies that you raise in connection with your place in the virtual 2021 Virgin Money London Marathon 2021 must be paid to Hospice Isle of Man within 4 weeks of the event date. If a deficit to the minimum sponsorship amount remains at this point, we will contact you to discuss plans for paying or fundraising for the remaining.
5. If your application is successful, you will also be required to sign up to and comply with the virtual 2021 Virgin Money London Marathon 2021 event rules and terms and conditions. Please note that Hospice Isle of Man is not responsible for the organisation or management of the marathon event and therefore we shall have no liability for any injury, damage or loss suffered by you when taking part in the event.

### **You agree that your fundraising will not include:**

1. Raising funds by carrying out door-to-door or unsolicited collections.
2. Collecting in any public place without first obtaining authorisation from the local authority and any other licences or consent that you are required to obtain.
3. Collecting on private property (including shops, pubs etc) without first obtaining permission of the owner of the private property.
4. Conducting any raffle or lottery or putting on any public Event without the required licenses. Hospice Isle of Man can provide advice on what these are.

## Personal Data and Images

1. During the event we may take general photographs and film which may be used for social media, on our website, in the media and in print or digital material as marketing to promote future events. We will ask your permission before taking individual and group photographs of participants but you may sometimes appear in general photographs of crowds and the event setting.
2. You give permission for your personal information to be stored and used by Hospice Isle of Man in connection with the organisation, promotion and administration of this Event and any other Events or promotions.
3. Contact details provided are used to keep you up to date about the event you are taking part in. We may ask for next of kin details in case of an emergency. All details will be stored securely and are used in relation to the event you are taking part in.
4. You give permission for your personal information to be passed on to the Event Organiser by Hospice Isle of Man for the purposes of the organisation and administration of this Event.
5. We are committed to protecting your privacy - view our [Privacy Policy](#). We reserve the right to amend these rules at any time without prior notice. Where we amend the rules, we will publish an up to date copy of those rules on our website.

## Health, Safety and Fitness

1. The Hospice Isle of Man Fundraising Team reserves the right to terminate an individual's entry on health and safety grounds.
2. In the case of an emergency throughout the event period, Hospice Isle of Man may use the emergency contact details you provided to us when you registered for the event.
3. Hospice Isle of Man takes reasonable steps to minimise the risk of injury to all participants during organised events. A risk assessment process is in place for the event this has been created by Virgin Money London Marathon. By taking part in an event, you acknowledge that there may be conditions or circumstances beyond our control that can lead to unforeseen risks. If you have any concerns or queries please contact us before agreeing to take part in an event.
