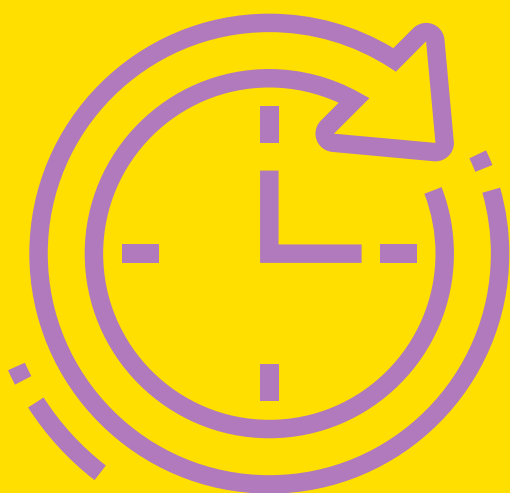

Service Deliverables

Patient care at home:
including care and nursing homes

Collect and deliver medication and specialist equipment

Liaison with other healthcare professionals in the community



The team, comprising of Registered Nurses and Health Care Assistants, work 24/7, 365 days a year and they remain the only specialist palliative care nursing team available to deliver care to dying patients out of hours i.e. after 5pm and before 9am in the community

Our referral process involves being assessed by our Palliative Care Clinical Nurse Specialist (PCCNS) Team. A senior clinical professional can make a referral to the PCCNS.
