When a volunteer is recruited the following takes place:

Initial interview and tour of the building – It is important we find out what areas our volunteers wish to assist in and a little more about them. It also gives us the opportunity to show them around the building and explain about Hospice and how it works.

Reference Taken – Each new volunteer must supply us with a name and address of a reference.

DBS Undertaken – All volunteers are police checked.

Training – In the appropriate area they will be working in - a new volunteer will work with either a permanent member of staff or another volunteer to learn their role - ongoing training continues through their time here

Induction Day – All new volunteers are encouraged to attend our in-house training day with our Education Department - this is a full day and also allows them to meet other members of the team from different areas.
