Day shift- 07.00-15.00 (early)/ 13.00-21.00 (late)

Staffing – For every patient on the In Patient unit there is at least one registered nurse allocated to oversee that patients' needs are met. Each patient is assessed on their dependency levels and this will determine whether 2-3 staff or more are required to help and look after the patient.

Meals – Breakfast, lunch and dinner plus regular snacks (if requested) are provided fresh every day by our catering staff at a time to suit our patients. The nursing staff assist those patients who require help with eating. The catering staff also provides meals for family members should it be necessary.

Personal Care – Our experienced nursing team provides personal care on a daily basis which may include a Jacuzzi bath or a trip to our in-house hairdresser for styling. We also offer manicures and pedicure. We also provide profiling beds, pressure relieving mattresses and electric recliners to ensure our patients feel as comfortable as possible.

Symptom Management – Our Hospice Doctor visits each patient daily and is skilled in managing patient symptoms such as pain, breathlessness or nausea. Experienced Registered nurses administer medication and monitor effectiveness liaising closely with the Doctor. The Hospice Occupational Therapist and Physiotherapist utilise non drug interventions such as relaxation, breathing exercises and TENS to aid symptom management.

Support – Our Hospice counsellor, complementary therapists, social worker and chaplain are always available to our In-patients to assist and support them and their carers in any way they can.
